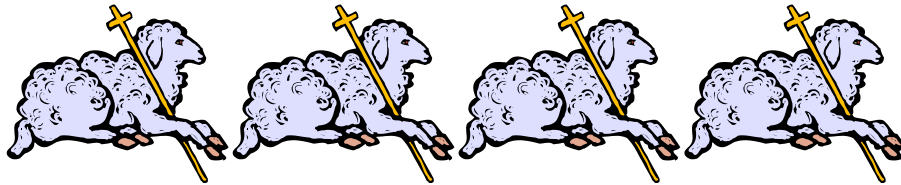


The Good Shepherd School
